

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

DISTRICT INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING, UNNAO

AND

DEPARTMENT OF TEACHER EDUCATION, D.B.S COLLEGE, KANPUR

For Collaboration and Cooperation in Research

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into between District Institute of Education and Training, Unnao Diet (A unit of SCERT Lucknow) – 209111 hereinafter called DIET, Unnao

And

Department of Teacher Education, D.B.S. College, Kanpur - Kanpur

Sharing a common desire to extend and strengthen the functional relationship between DIET Unnao, and, Department of Teacher Education, D.B.S. College, Kanpur - we the undersigned, mutually agree to share existing facilities and available expertise at our respective institutions viz. DIET Unnao and, Department of Teacher Education, D.B.S. College, Kanpur – Kanpur, by signing a MoU on 24.07.24 which reads as follows:

ARTICLE 1: AREAS OF COOPERATION

1.1 Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular, to promote national and global academic cooperation in the following areas:

- a) Institutional exchanges between faculty and staff from each partner institution.
- b) Organization of symposia, conferences, orientation programmers, training programmers, faculty and staff development programmers, short-term courses and meetings on research issues.
- c) Exchange of information pertaining to developments in teaching, student development and research activities.

- d) Mutually promote information and activities of the other Party within the scope of the Memorandum of Understanding on their respective websites (subject to prior written approval for the use of any logos or trademarks).
 - e) Submit collaborative research projects for funding to national and international agencies on relevant subjects, themes or topics on agreed terms and conditions.
 - f) Promote and support student and faculty exchange programs.
 - g) Provide access to infrastructure, academic and technical support, subject to availability.
 - h) Co-operation in any other areas or specific areas and details will be implemented upon mutual agreement and will be outlined in separate agreement and cooperation and addendum to this memorandum upon its signature by the authorized representative as agreed to by the Parties from time to time.
- 1.2 For the purpose of implementing the cooperation in respect of any areas not stated in paragraph 1.1, the Parties shall enter into legally binding agreements subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the parties, including clauses on “confidentiality”, “suspension”, “protection of intellectual property rights” and “settlement of disputes”.

ARTICLE 2: Financial Arrangements

This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.

ARTICLE 3: Effect of Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied, under domestic or international law.

ARTICLE 4: Entry into Effect

This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective as of the date of signatures of both parties and, if the dates vary, the date of the later signature.

ARTICLE 5: IPR

- 5.1 Both Parties undertake that they shall not infringe upon any copyright or any right in exclusive possession of the respective Parties. Both parties shall obtain permission in writing to use any logo, motif, emblem, or any other intellectual property right vested in the respective Parties to be used in connection with the implementation of the present MOU from the respective Party. Each Party is the sole owner of such intellectual property.

5.2 Neither Party may use the other party's intellectual property rights without the prior consent of that Party. Nothing contained in this MOU is intended to, or shall be construed as grant to either Party any license or right regarding the other Party's Intellectual Property Rights.

ARTICLE 6: Publications

6.1 Publications, if any, in respect of the activities covered under this MOU shall be in the names of involved personnel from both parties. In all publications (papers, reports etc.,) it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out by D.B.S. College, Kanpur and DIET Unnao under this MOU between the parties.

6.2 All ethical guidelines of research publication existent at both Institutions will be followed strictly.

ARTICLE 7: Force Majeure

Both parties shall have no liability in respect of any delay in carrying out the activities or failure to carry out the activities under this MoU caused due to any acts of the government or any circumstances outside the reasonable control of the parties hereto.

ARTICLE 8: Dispute Resolution

All disputes and differences concerning the validity, scope, meaning construction or effect of this MoU or any dispute or disagreement between the parties hereto as to any matter relating to this memorandum which cannot be settled by mutual discussion shall be settled by arbitration by an arbitrator, appointed by consent of both parties.

ARTICLE 9: Duration

The MoU shall be effective from the date of signing and remain in force for **five years**.


ARTICLE 10: TERMINATION




